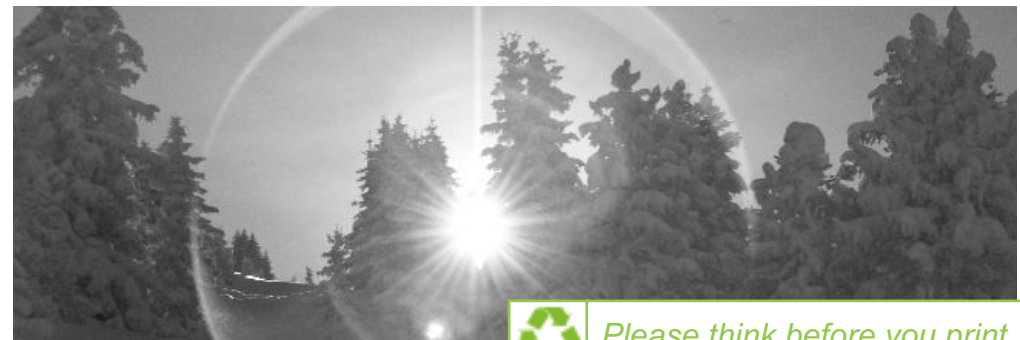

BASI Alpine Level 1 Instructor Course

This is the entry level course for students who wish to join the BASI Education System. The qualification is for those wishing to find employment in a non mountain environment, i.e. Dry Slopes and Indoor Snowslopes. It is also the 1st stage of the BASI Alpine Instructor Training Course.

Our team are ready to introduce you to the world of ski teaching! Who can apply?

Before applying for the Instructor course, students must meet the following criteria:

- Be able to ski confidently, coping with a variety of conditions and have completed at least 16 weeks on snow
- Ski confidently parallel on black runs, being able to make rhythmical turns close to the fall line at a steady pace
- Be able to ski confidently and in control in off-piste conditions
- Have an understanding of Client Care
- Be 16 years of age or older

Alpine Level 1 Instructor Course

This is a 5 day on-snow training and assessment course in which the following subjects are covered and assessed:

- Skiing safely
- Participating in an accident and emergency activity
- Planning, conducting and evaluating an instructing session
- Knowing and understanding how to improve personal skiing and instructing performance

On completion of this course, students will have an understanding of:

- The Central Theme and Beyond
- The Skiers' Code of Conduct (FIS)
- The Principles of Ski Teaching
- The Structure of Snowsports in the UK
- The Roles of Snowsport Agencies in the UK
- Marketing and Promoting Snowsports in the UK
- Dealing with accidents and emergencies

Qualification

Successful students will be issued a certificate of competence. Students will be able to work at the UK indoor and dry slopes if they also obtain their First Aid and Child Protection Certificates (Both these certificates must be for approved BASI courses).

On completion of the Alpine Level 1 course all students are individually debriefed and advised on the degree of preparation required before presenting themselves for the BASI Alpine Level 2 Instructor Course. If required standards are not met during the assessment, students may be required to repeat the Alpine Level 1 Course.

Resources

The course fee includes all course materials plus copies of the BASI Manual and Alpine Manual which will be handed out at the start of the course.





Course Dates and Fees

Please note that all course dates are on-snow dates and do NOT include travel time to and from the course. All of the courses run on-snow from Monday through to Friday and will start with a Sunday evening briefing and registration.

Pre-Season Preperation Course

The New Generation pre-season training course offer students the best support and preparation for the Alpine Level 1 Course.

The course runs for 5 hours on-snow each day with evening video feedback sessions. The 1 week course runs over 6 days, Sunday - Friday. Wednesday is a rest day and provides a back up if there is a bad weather day.

Our goal is to give you the technical knowledge and support you need to make you succeed in the first stage of your instructor career. The training courses have been specifically designed to prepare you for the Alpine Level 1 assessment.

Ski School Experience Weeks

The new BASI rules state that once you have completed your Alpine Level 1 Instructor course, you need a First Aid Certificate, your child protection module and 35 hours ski school experience before you can work on a dry / indoor slope.

Before you can attend your Level 2 Instructor Course a minimum of 70 hours of ski school experience is required. Here at New Generation we find shadowing and taking part in lessons delivered by our fully qualified instructors to be the most effective way of gaining ski school experience. So why not join us on one of our ski school experience weeks.

The New Generation course gives you 35 hours of Ski School Experience. At the end of the course we will give you a letter confirming these hours. You will then need to pass this on to BASI.

Who can apply? Anyone who has successfully completed their Alpine Level 1 Instructor Course.

Stage 1: Select the course you wish to join. e.g. BASI Alpine Level 1

Stage 2: Select the appropriate course - check the date as we have more than one running

Stage 3: Enter your name and age in the appropriate boxes. If you are under 18 we will send you a parental consent form by post to fill out.

Stage 4: Check the lesson details. If you are happy then click 'Go To The Checkout'.
